Please accept my donation to the San Mateo County Community College District Foundation that will be applied to the Vera Quijano Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship Fund.

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist Cañada College students pursuing careers in Visual and Performing Arts. Visual and Performing Arts are defined as dance, music, photography, drama, painting, sculpting, drawing, architecture, graphic design, mixed media, animation and gaming, multimedia, and museum studies. Students must have at least a 3.0 GPA, demonstrate financial need, and be accepted by and transferring to a baccalaureate and/or graduate degree program at an accredited institution majoring in a Visual and Performing Arts program as defined above. The scholarship award will be \$1,000. Three to five awards will be given subject to available funds. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in at least 12.0 units at the time the scholarship funds are disbursed. The Scholarship is to be used for tuition only. Exceptions may be made due to unusual circumstances under the discretion of Vera Quijano and/or the Cañada College Scholarship Committee.
